ENTRY DETAILS

Team registration opens 31st July 2023, close 31st August 2023. Players listed in team entry will receive nomination form by email to be completed and pay in full by **31st October**, **2023 to** secure tournament singlet. **Fees include** tournament entry, tournament jersey. Please note players must complete payment with Nomination Form online for nomination to be accepted and eligible to play. Paypal and Credit Card payments available once form is submitted.

Team Managers All teams must have a nominated team manager. Team manager is responsible for ensuring all team members submit their individual entry forms and payment.

Elimination Finals: In 2024 Round Robin games will determine the team rankings followed by an elimination finals series determining medal placings. Number of divisions, games and elimination format are dependent on team entry numbers.

Definition									
Code of Conduct	All participants agree to abide by the player's Code of Conduct listed in the online nomination form. Any breach of this Code may result in suspension or expulsion from the event and venue.								
Team Grade Placement	Tournament Technical Committee will have the final say on the team grade placement and your team will be notified of any change before the tournament draw is distributed.								
Team Selection	Teams are selected by their regional coach, manager or team contact.								
Eligibility	Players must complete online nomination and pay in full to be eligible to play. Players must play over 50% of round games to be eligible for finals within their nominated grade (Finals includes semi and grand finals). Limit 2 games playing higher or lower grade, Players competing in a grade lower than their nominated grade will be ineligible to score points. Player competing in a grade other than their nominated grade must inform opposing team captain and referees before game commences. Non-compliance may result in team disqualification or competition point's deduction.								
Uniforms	Each team is responsible for providing playing sets, and must have a light and dark set available. Players must wear the same singlet number during the Tournament. Players may wear a shirt underneath their singlet the same color as the dominant color of the team singlet.

SCORE BENCH OFFICIALS

Teams must supply a score bench official for each game. Team acceptance into the competition is reliant on score bench official provision.

REPAIR STATION AND WHEELCHAIR STORAGE

A repair station will be available on site over the weekend to assist with minor repairs. All repairs will be at the individual's own cost.

There is no lock up storage at the venue. Chairs can be left at the stadium overnight and are left at your own risk. The stadium will be locked. The Tournament Committee and Venue takes no responsibility for personal belongings left on site.
